CONSTRUCTION WORK BEGINS

The Memorial Highway Improvements project officially kicks off today! Due to the colder temperatures, crews will begin on 19th St. SE, focusing on pavement stripping and temporary erosion control. As the weather warms, work will shift to “The Strip,” where traffic changes will start taking shape.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS:

- New concrete roadway with curb and gutter
- Storm sewer and drainage upgrades
- Underground utility enhancements
- Safer business access and upgraded lighting
- Shared-use path for pedestrians and cyclists



APRIL 1, 2025

WHAT HAPPENS FIRST?

TRAFFIC CHANGES:

- One lane in each direction with a center turn lane
- Speed limit reduced to 25 mph
- 11-foot width restriction

CONSTRUCTION PROGRESSION:

- Start at storm sewer east outfall and 19th street closure
- Move to 21st Street closure
- 40th Street lift station construction
- Begin half of roadway removals
