### Current Road Conditions Explained

If you've driven Memorial Highway lately, you may have noticed that the current roadway feels a little...uneven.

We've heard the comparisons: rollercoaster and wavy bacon. You're not imagining things.

But rest assured, this is temporary.

When the project is complete, Memorial Highway will feature a brand-new five-lane concrete roadway with curb and gutter. The final road will also be 2 to 3 feet lower than the old one to improve drainage along the entire corridor.

Right now, drivers are using a temporary asphalt surface that allows construction crews to continue work while maintaining access to local businesses. Since those businesses sit at varying elevations, some higher and some lower than the roadway, the current driving surface has some ups and downs to accommodate access safely.

We appreciate your patience as we work toward a smoother, safer, and more durable roadway.
